The body of the clarinet is machined on a 4 axis CNC machine for a highly consistent result. The Boehm French style key work is constructed from solid rigid German nickel-silver with durable nickel plated finish. MSRP: \$350

The body's ability to withstand changes in temperature and humidity practically eliminates the risk of cracks and is low maintenance. The body of the clarinet is machined on a 4 axis CNC machine for a highly consistent result. MSRP: \$485
